- 1. These regulations may be cited as the **Grand Port/Savanne District Council (Fees for Classified Trades) Regulations 2006**.
- 2. The fees specified in the second column of the Schedule shall be levied in respect of the corresponding classified trades specified in the first column of that Schedule.
- **3.** The Grand Port/Savanne District Council (payment for fees, dues or other charges) Regulations 2005 (GN. No. 103 of 2005) are revoked.
- **4.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 October 2006.
